

Bi-Monthly Buildings, Grounds/Parks Report

January 13, 2026

(final bi-monthly report for 2025)

- Myke/Pete/Noah made permanent holiday lighting brackets and installed the holiday lighting to the Town Hall and Library during the first week of November. This will save us roughly 4-5 hours of time during our holiday decorating season.
- Last week of October Pete/Noah/Zach closed up the Bullis Park facilities for the season. The Facilities are usually opened up approximately within the first week of April(weather depending).
- The whole Parks crew cleaned up all the leaves at Bickford Park and hauled them away to our leaf composting bin.
- Our new 2025 Ford F550 dump/plow truck was finally delivered on 11/12/25(finally, it took 11 months from the time we ordered it).
- Noah/Pete worked on wiring up the salt spreader equipment to the F550.
- The “ornamental grasses” were trimmed back for the winter at the Town Hall and Library by Zach, Noah and Pete.
- Pete/Noah installed the new Emma Sweet “Pomeroy historical marker” sign (3rd sign as the previous 2 were damaged) along Rt. 31 in front of the Town Hall.
- Myke and Noah installed the Bickford Park sign and built an upper accent wall(using left over materials from the building project) to the new pavilion/gazebo and installed a smaller Bickford sign(was ordered incorrect size as replacement to original sign) to it.
- A new historical sign for the old “Lock 61 Spillway” was installed to the entrance of the ABX overflow parking lot(east side of Rt. 350). This is near where the actual spillway is located. Installation was done by Zach and Pete.

- The week of Thanksgiving we installed the “big holiday tree” on the corner of Rt. 31/350 and put up some smaller lighted trees. The highway dept. helped us transport the tree as it is so large.
- Pete/Noah took down the “green Historical” banners and installed the holiday banners to Rt. 31f in Macedon Center and along Rt. 31/Main St. Between Gravino Park area and Kemp Dr.
- Zach and Myke installed the wreaths to the Town Hall and Library.
- Zach/Noah did monthly building inspection.
- Zach/Noah/Pete all took on plowing/salting duties with the first snowfall of the season. This way all the guys could get acclimated/comfortable with how this process works.
- On 12/2/25 [REDACTED] had an accident with our new F550 [REDACTED] backed into one of the light poles in the Town Hall/Library parking lot. The light pole was knocked down and the new truck has some pretty significant the rear axle, driveshaft, rim & tire, and many other major rear end/chassis parts. The truck has been taken out of service and is waiting on insurance and repair.
- Myke plowed the “old village area” sidewalks on 12/2/25 for the first time of the winter season. The V plow must of snagged something while plowing and broke the cutting edge.
- Pete and Noah worked on fixing/fabricating the new cutting edge for the sidewalk V plow and got it back up and in working order within a day.
- Myke/Noah/Pete all took some time working on refurbishing the “veterans name plaques” display cases. This entailed sanding and staining the cases and sealing them so they will look fresh and new for 2026. We will be re-installing them into the new Veterans pavilion late winter/early spring. This will be done before Memorial Day.
- Noah cleaned up all the zero turn mowers after a long mowing season.

- We have been working on tree trimming along the “old roadway” walking path at Bullis Park. We are pruning up low hanging branches, dead limbs, and clearing out dead ash trees. We are trying to clean up along the walking path for people that use it and so we can maintain it easier.
