

# **Bi-Monthly Buildings, Grounds/Parks Report**

**March 4th, 2026**

- New Chevy Silverado(lease) was delivered 12/31/25
- The week of 1/5/26 we took down all of the holiday decorations(banners, wreaths, trees, and lighting) and put back into storage.
- 1/11-1/12 Myke/Pete dug out old sewer line from Gravino Park bathroom. We dug back approx.. 20' to expose where we can tie the new sewer line from the bathroom remodel project.
- Between 1/12-1/23 we were working on limbing up trees and cutting dead trees down at Bullis Park.
- Noah and Pete did January building inspections
- We dropped off the new 2026 Silverado to Ewing Graphics to get the decals installed.
- Myke walked potential carpet cleaning companies through the Town Hall, Library and the Public Safety Bldg. to get estimates on the cleaning of carpets in the buildings.
- Noah serviced both of the Polaris Ranger UTV's on 1/22 and 1/26
- We had some electrical work done in the shop, relocating some old lights and installing some new lights where needed. Jay Harding Electric performed the work assisted by Pete.
- Pete, Noah and Myke have all taken part in plowing duties. This includes plowing town parking lots and parks lots, shoveling sidewalk areas where needed and plowing "old village sidewalks".

- We had to do some snow removal 1/26/26 after we accumulated around a foot of snow so that we would have room to keep the lots clear.
- Myke did interviews for the FT Parks position the week of 1/26, that had been empty since the beginning of December.
- 1/27/26-1/29/26 Noah worked on servicing our fleet of Zero turn mowers to get them ready for the season ahead of us.
- Pete serviced the Vermeer ATX mini loader on 1/26 and the Bobcat T110 skid steer on 1/29. During the service he noticed a broken exhaust manifold and flex pipe which we ordered to get fixed.
- We had one Main St. bench with broken slats so I talked with Barco Products and they sent us all new slats free of charge and Noah fixed the bench when the parts came in. During this time another bench purchased through the Town Historian came in and we assembled that so that can be installed within the “Butterfly Trail” when the Historian and Myke can decide on a good location.
- Noah and Pete worked on the Bobcat T110 exhaust when the parts were in. They got it all together later in the day on 2/12 as the parts didn’t come in until early afternoon. As a result of the machine being down, the sidewalks didn’t get done as this is our sidewalk machine but we did attempt to try to clear the sidewalks with our ATX mini loader but it didn’t perform like the skid steer does. After the Bobcat was all back together Noah went out and cleared all the sidewalks.
- Pete serviced the New Holland 555E backhoe on 2/4, while doing the service we noticed some bad hydraulic lines that needed to be replaced. On 2/5 Noah and Pete replaced old worn out hydraulic lines.
- Pete did oil changes on our 2011 Ford F150 and our 2023 Chevy Silverado.

- There were a couple trees across the canal trail off of Canandaigua Rd., they were blocking the trail so we cut them up and removed them from the trail so that people could get through.
- Pete went to Great Lakes Equipment and picked up our new SCAG Cheetah zero turn mower that was approved in our 26' budget.
- The library had a toilet leaking issue in the women's restroom 2/9 so we fixed the problem and the next day in the women's room a different toilet leaking(different plumbing fixture) that Pete went and took care of on 2/10.
- 2/11 we had a report of a wet spot on the carpet at the library so we went to check it out. We weren't sure of the cause so we ended up cutting into the wall to see if the plumbing in the wall was leaking. We didn't see any issues and basically ran a dehumidifier over night to see if the spot would dry up and it did. So we think somebody must of spilled water and we patched the wall back up but what we did was for precautionary measures so that we didn't have a bigger issue later on.
- Noah was on vacation from 2/15-2/22
- Went to Ewing Graphics and picked up new Police Dept. sign(that had blown off the building and broke) and new parking lot signs for Bullis Park.
- Pete installed new storage shelves in Sams office on 2/18
- Myke refurbished "old" Bullis Park signs in between projects and other work.
- 2/19 we installed the new Police Dept. sign to the building.
- Pete took skid steer to Erie St. to remove a big pile of snow that a private contractor had plowed onto the sidewalk. A resident had complained and we took care of it so that it didn't become a bigger problem.

- Noah worked on sanding and painting an old fireproof cabinet so that we could use it for our supplies.
- 2/25 Pete and Noah had started on sanding and prepping the stall dividers in the boys restroom at Bullis Park as they were all rusted and in need of an upgrade. When ready they painted the dividers.
- 2/26 We started to paint the boys and girls restrooms at Bullis to freshen them up.
- Myke cleaned up our oldest Scag Cheetah zero turn mower which is surplussed equipment approved by the Town Board for 26'. After getting it prepped and ready, there were pictures taken and sent to Auctions international for their online auction.
