RESOLUTION NO. 95 (2026) MACEDON TOWN COURT RESTROOMS – CHANGE ORDER #1

WHEREAS, the Town has commenced a project whereby restrooms are being constructed at the Macedon Town Court; and

WHEREAS, Loyal 9 Development is the awarded General Construction Contractor for the project with a contract in the amount of \$261,944 as authorized by Town Board Resolution 219-2025, and

WHEREAS, as during the reconciliation of the design delegated portion of the structural steel installation, additional costs beyond the original bid scope of work were identified, and

WHEREAS, the Project Architect Labella Associates and Town Engineer have reviewed the documentation provided and recommend the acceptance of this Change Order,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board authorizes the Supervisor to sign Change Order number 1 for the Court Bathroom Project in the amount of \$7,918.64 to be expensed out of A1990.400 to the Town Court Restroom Capital Project Fund

RESOLUTION NO. 96 (2026) RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE NEW YORK PLAYS FOR LEARNING, ACTIVITY, AND YOUTH SOCIALIZATION (NY PLAYS) INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (DASNY), in coordination with the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP), administers the New York Places for Learning, Activity, and Youth Socialization (NY PLAYS) Initiative, a competitive grant program supporting the design, construction, expansion, and renovation of public playgrounds across New York State; and

WHEREAS, the NY PLAYS Initiative provides grants ranging from \$100,000 to \$2,500,000 for eligible playground projects that promote youth physical activity, outdoor recreation, and community wellness; and

WHEREAS, municipalities applying to the NY PLAYS Initiative must demonstrate project readiness, planning efforts, and local support as part of the application evaluation process; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Macedon has identified the need to enhance recreational opportunities and playground facilities for residents and youth within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Macedon desires to submit an application to the NY PLAYS Initiative for funding assistance for the Bullis Park Playground Expansion; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Town of Macedon supports the development and implementation of this project and acknowledges the planning efforts undertaken to advance the project concept;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Macedon hereby authorizes the submission of an application to the New York Plays for Learning, Activity, and Youth Socialization (NY PLAYS) Initiative for funding assistance for the Bullis Park Playground Expansion; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Town Supervisor, is hereby authorized and directed to execute and submit all necessary documents, forms, and certifications required to apply for and administer NY PLAYS grant funding; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Macedon acknowledges its responsibility to comply with all applicable program requirements should the project be awarded funding.

RESOLUTION NO. 97 (2026) RESOLUTION COMMITTING LOCAL MATCH FOR NY PLAYS GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Town of Macedon intends to submit an application to the New York Places for Learning, Activity, and Youth Socialization (NY PLAYS) Initiative, administered by the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (DASNY); and

WHEREAS, the NY PLAYS Initiative requires applicants to provide a minimum 20 percent local match toward total project costs for any grant award received; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Bullis Park Playground Expansion will improve access to safe, inclusive, and engaging outdoor recreation opportunities for residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Macedon recognizes the importance of investing in high-quality park and playground infrastructure to support youth development, physical activity, and community well-being;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Town Board of the Town of Macedon hereby commits to providing the required local match for the proposed Bullis Park Playground Expansion should funding be awarded through the NY PLAYS Initiative; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Macedon commits to providing a minimum local match in the amount of: \$80,000 which represents at least twenty percent (20%) of the total project cost and all other expenses required to complete the project deemed ineligible by program guidance related to the NY PLAYS application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governing body authorizes the appropriate municipal officials to allocate and secure these funds through municipal budget appropriations, capital funds, grants, donations, or other eligible funding sources in accordance with program requirements.
