WHEREAS, the Town of Macedon Ambulance Service participates in provider billing programs and seeks reimbursement for ambulance and emergency medical services provided to eligible individuals; and

WHEREAS, the applicable reimbursement and billing programs require the submission of a Certification Statement for Provider Billing executed by an authorized representative of the provider; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Macedon desires to designate Town Supervisor Kim V. Leonard as the authorized representative for purposes of executing such certifications and related documents; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Macedon hereby authorizes Town Supervisor Kim V. Leonard to execute and submit the Certification Statement for Provider Billing on behalf of the Town of Macedon Ambulance service, together with any amendments, renewals, assurances, certifications, or related documents required by the applicable agency or program administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Macedon is seeking to construct Fuel Storage Tanks and an associated User Accounting System at the Town Highway Facility,

AND WHEREAS, the Town Board authorized an RFP – Request for Proposals to be advertised for this project dated May 15, 2026 seeking a qualified vendor to provide the Fuel Storage Tanks and user monitoring system,

AND WHEREAS, the following vendors submitted responses to the RFP:

Lavalley Brothers Construction, Inc. – Wolcott, NY	Total Price: \$74,851.00
L&O Mechanical Contractors – Macedon, NY	Total Price: \$88,380.00

AND WHEREAS, the RFP was advertised as a Best Value procurement,

AND WHEREAS, the submittals from the two vendors were reviewed by the Town Engineer and the Town Highway Superintendent for compliance with the bid specifications, along with the vendors ability to do the work, and best overall value to the Town, and are recommending the Town Board select Lavalley Brothers as the vendor for the project,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board selects Lavalley Brothers Construction, Inc. as the successful Vendor for the project and authorizes the Town Supervisor to sign contracts for the procurement of the tanks and monitoring systems in an amount not to exceed \$74,851.00.
