Here are some notes and questions regarding the Hometown Heroes Banner Project.

Post 494 (Legion, Auxiliary & Sons) had an understanding that, as representatives of and advocates for the local veteran community, we would be involved in the selection committee. We donated/raised funds and lent our credibility to this effort. The application packet refers repeatedly to the American Legion's involvement in the committee. However, it appears that decisions regarding qualifications and selection appear to have been handled via summary judgment by Ms. Dorfner without any committee review.

My questions, which Ms. Dorfner refused to address:

- Is there a committee? Who is on it? Is it a registered 501c3?
- Where can we find documented qualification criteria?
- What defines the boundaries of Macedon for consideration?
- How were the current honorees selected?

We look forward to discussing this further and coming to a satisfactory resolution.

Per Councilwoman Dorfner - “ As a sitting Board Member I have to recuse myself from the conversation per my attorney”.

The Town of Macedon received a postcard from the Macedon Public Library thanking the Town for the carpet cleaning at the library.

There was discussion regarding Canal Drive East, as they have received calls reporting that the Macedon Police have told residents that Canal Drive East is not their jurisdiction. The Town would like residents to know that Canal Drive East and West are under the jurisdiction of the Macedon Police Department.
